

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
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
ACO METRICS




ACO Metrics display the clinical quality measures required for Accountable Care Organization and Value Based Payment program reporting. Measures cover care coordination, patient safety, preventive health, and at-risk populations.



Preventive Care Patients by Performance –Met displays a trend line comparison of last year to current month and year.



Preventive Care Patients by Performance displays a monthly summary of patients who have completed (Met) and those who have not (Not Met).



Preventive Care Records by Measure-selecting a bar from this chart will open up a patient list of details for each measure.



Administrator Patient Pool Review

Patient Pool Review tab shows a list of patients that are in the logged-in administrator’s security group. It also allows the Practice Administrator to review the patient lists for individual providers. Practice Administrators can exclude and re-include patients from a provider’s pool (only when they are viewing a single provider's patient list as set by the Provider quickview). Practice Administrators can also submit a provider change request for a patient to SVMS.


The display lists the following fields for each of the patients:

- **Basic demographics:** Name, DOB and Gender
- **Encounters at Facility** - count of the patient's visits within the client's facilities.
- **Encounters at Other Facilities** - count of the patient's visits outside of the client's facilities.
- **Most Recent Encounter Date at Facility** - the date of patient's last visit within the client's facilities.
- **Not Seen at Facility in 18 Months** - a red indicator marks any patient that has not had a visit with the client in the last 18 months, blank otherwise.
- **Most Recent Provider at Facility** - the latest provider name available on the patient's visits.
- **Most Recent Primary Payer at Facility** - the latest primary name available on the patient's visits within the client facilities.
- **Included?** - a checkbox indicating if the patient is included (dark green) or excluded from (white) a provider's or administrator's view.
- **Payer Attributed?** - A checkbox indicating if a patient has been marked as payer attributed. This checkbox is white by default, and green if a Practice Administrator has attributed a payer to the patient. The setting is practice/client-wide, and not on a per-provider basis
- **Last Pool Status Change** - the date and time of the last edit to a patient's Included/Excluded status

- **Patient Has >1 Provider** - a circular red alert displayed for any patient that has been assigned to more than one provider within the client/practice.
- **Patient Has No Provider** - a circular red alert displayed for any patient that has not been assigned to a provider




Filters

The Patient Pool report can be filtered by the following

- **Status** - filters the report to show only Included patients, only Excluded patients, or All patients (default) for the provider.
- **Attributed Payer** - filters the report to only those patients that a Practice Administrator has marked as attributed to a particular payer. The default is to show all patients.
- **Not Seen in 18+ Months** - filters the report to show only those patients for which the condition is True or False. The default settings show all patients.
- **First Initial** - filters the report to only patients whose first initial starts with the selected character. The default settings show all values.
- **Last Initial** - filters the report to only patients whose last initial starts with the selected character. The default settings show all values.
- **Limit Rows To** - sets the number of patients to show in the report. The default is 10



Patient Encounter Detail Click-Action - Clicking on any non-indicator column for a patient in the Patient Pool report pops up a new page with the Encounter Detail report for the selected patient. The page shows the patient name, the selected administrator or provider security group, the Included? status (which can be edited if a provider security group was selected), the Payer Attributed? status for the patient (which can be edited if the administrator group was selected), and a list of all the encounters for the patient.

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

Request Provider Change - Clicking on any patient in the Patient Pool report allows the user to select the Request Provider Change menu item. This navigates to a new page that lists all the security groups the selected patient has been assigned to. A round green Add allows a user to request a new provider security group assignment for the patient. A round red Remove allows a user to request that a patient be removed from a provider security group. The page also shows a list of all the Add and Remove requests that have been submitted for the patient.



Edit Payer List: shows the list of payers that can be attributed to patients, and allows the Practice Administrator to edit the list by adding new Payers, editing existing Payers, or disabling an existing Payer. (Note: disabled Payers will not show up as options when editing Payer Attributed for a patient, but they are not deleted so as to be able to report on report on any patients that still have those disabled payers attributed.)

Edit Provider Settings Button - The current selection of whether the Provider Settings should be applied to the Practice Administrator's view of patients is displayed under the Patient Pool report. Provider Settings=Disabled means the provider exclusions or assignments for patients have no effect on the administrator's view of the patients; Enabled means provider exclusions affect the administrator's view. The Edit Provider Settings button under the Patient Pool report takes the user to a page where the user can change the Provider Settings between Enabled and Disabled states. By default, Provider Settings are disabled for all clients.

Go to Dashboards - takes the user to the main menu for the data dashboards



Interactive Features

- **Included?** When a Provider's security group is chosen from the Provider quickview, the patient list is limited to that Provider's patients. The Included checkbox becomes interactive on each patient's row, allowing the user to click on it and toggle the Included/Excluded status of that patient in the selected provider's view. The popup window that appears on a user click allows the user to select an Exclude Reason, and select OK to save the Inclusion/Exclusion edit. Editing the Include? checkbox status updates the Last Pool Status Change field also.

Note: after changing the Include? status for one or more patients, a user needs to log out and log back in to the dashboards to see the new Included/Excluded settings effected on the data dashboards.

When the Administrator's security group is chosen from the Provider quickview, the patient list displays all patients within the practice/client. The Included? checkbox in this view is a display-only alert (green for included, white for excluded). Patient exclusions cannot be set explicitly for a Practice Administrator; they are determined by the exclusions set by all the providers that a patient is assigned to at the client. If Provider Settings for the client's Admin Group have been enabled, then any patient in the Practice Administrator's view that has not been assigned to a Provider group, or has been excluded by all Providers, will be deemed excluded for the Practice Administrator. If the Provider Settings for the client's Group have been disabled, then the Practice Administrator's view includes all patients assigned to the administrator, whether or not they are assigned to or excluded from Provider views.




Know when your patient has a visit somewhere else in real-time!

Starting in Spring of 2021 (twelve months after the publication of the final rule), CMS’s Medicare CoPs for hospitals and CAHs will require that they send electronic patient ADT event notifications to other health care facilities or community providers.


Alerting reduces readmissions (inside and outside of your system) and avoidable ED visits, improves the quality of care for at-risk patients during transitions of care, and reduces overall healthcare costs.

- The AcuteAlerts notification includes the patient’s name, the treating provider’s name, sending institution’s name and admit, transfer and discharge date and time, meeting CoP requirements.
- The AcuteAlerts is sent electronically to the patient’s care provider/practice, applicable post-acute care provider, or other providers identified by the patient.
- Provider(s) are notified by email that they have received an AcuteAlerts for their patient. They are directed to a secure website to view the patient information. The Admission, Discharge and Transfer (ADT) feed from the hospital is utilized to electronically identify patients and alert their providers.
- AcuteAlerts provides the alerts in near real-time by leveraging existing capabilities in the SacValley MedShare health information exchange platform.
- AcuteAlerts inform transitions of care in clinical workflow, so care teams can proactively engage and monitor patients after they are discharged from the hospital or admitted to an ER.
- Alerts can be delivered to a patient’s established PCP, established primary care practice group, or other practitioners/groups identified by the patient as primarily responsible for his or her care.



BEHAVIORAL HEALTH



Behavioral Health measures are structured to track screenings for patients with serious mental illness conditions of bipolar disorder, schizophrenia, and depression. Each measure has specific requirements available for review in the Appendix.

Performance displays three categories of calculation.

Met - The patient has fallen into both the numerator and denominator requirements including any office visit criteria.

Not Met - The patient meets the denominator criteria and has eligible office visits during the measurement period, but no evidence of the screening completed.

Unreported - The patient meets requirements for the metric, but does **not** have the required office visit.

Period identifies the reported timeframe.


Current - This is the current calendar year.

Previous - This is the previous calendar year.

Historical - This is anything prior to the 'Previous Reporting Period' time frame












Controlled Substances Prescription Distribution









Top 5 Conditions: Display in descending order. Hover over provides summary number of patients.

Gender and Age: Displays distribution for selected condition. Filter by gender and 4 age ranges.

Pie Chart: Displays the prevalence of the disease conditions in the client

Disease registries display a list of patients in the population that meet the defined criteria. **This differs from High Risk** patients in that patients on this list may have only 1 condition and no Emergency Department activity.

Potential Use: Identify high population with certain high risk or "at risk" diagnoses or lab values. Currently criteria are listed in the selections. See the Appendix for ranges of codes.


1. **A1c Poor Control** are patients with a **diagnosis of Diabetes** and a lab value for **Hemoglobin A1c that is 9% or greater**.
2. **A1c Range 5.7-6.4%** criteria is patients **without Diabetes** and a **lab value of Hemoglobin A1c** in the defined range. It identifies "at risk" patients.
3. **Acute Myocardial Infarction** lists patients treated with a **diagnosis of Acute MI** as defined on the Appendix.



4. **BG 100-125** lists patients who are **not diabetic** and have a **blood glucose** within the 100-125 mg/dl range, another "at risk" for diabetes indicator.
5. **BG>125** displays **non-diabetic patients** with **blood glucose higher than 125 mg/dl** . Potentially at even higher "risk" for diabetes.
6. **Diabetes:** All patients in population with **diagnosis of Diabetes**.
7. **Heart Failure:** Patients identified with diagnosis of **Heart Failure** (see Appendix for specific codes)
8. **Hypertension:** Patients identified with **Essential Hypertension**
9. **Ischemic Heart Disease:** Patients diagnosed with **ischemic heart disease** condition.
10. **Pre diabetes:** List of patients who were diagnosed with certain **Pre-Diabetic diagnoses**, Impaired Glucose
11. **Stroke Transient Ischemic Attack (TIA):** Those with a diagnosed condition of **Stroke or TIA** in the patient population.
12. **Tobacco User:** Those with a confirmed diagnosis of Tobacco Use (does not include counseling).
13. **Bipolar Disorder:** Patients diagnosed with **Bipolar Disorder**.
14. **Schizophrenia:** patients in population diagnosed with **Schizophrenia**.















Can be limited to 1 facility to note differences. NOTE: Facility with most recent use of the chronic diagnosis is identified as the source. PDF option available.






Population Health intended for use to identify and plan for population health needs on a **defined geographic regional basis**, not restricted to client specific population. Data displayed has been modified to comply with HIPAA de-identification rules.


Potential Use: Identify high population for a geographic region with certain high risk or "at risk" diagnoses or lab values.
Community health resource coordination and planning.

Current Criteria

1. **A1c Poor Control** are patients with a **diagnosis of Diabetes** and a lab value for **Hemoglobin A1c that is 9% or greater**.
2. **A1c Range 5.7-6.4%** criteria is patients **without Diabetes** and a **lab value of Hemoglobin A1c** in the defined range. It identifies "at risk" patients.
3. **Acute Myocardial Infarction** lists patients treated with a **diagnosis of Acute MI** as defined on the Appendix.
4. **BG 100-125** lists patients who are **not diabetic** and have a **blood glucose** within the 100-125 mg/dl range, another "at risk" for diabetes indicator.
5. **BG>125** displays **non-diabetic patients** with **blood glucose higher than 125 mg/dl** . Potentially at even higher "risk" for diabetes.
6. **Diabetes:** All patients in population with **diagnosis of Diabetes**.
7. **Heart Failure:** Patients identified with diagnosis of **Heart Failure** (see Appendix for specific codes)
8. **Hypertension:** Patients identified with **Essential Hypertension**
9. **Ischemic Heart Disease:** Patients diagnosed with **ischemic heart disease** condition.
10. **Prediabetes:** Patients who were diagnosed with certain **Pre-Diabetic diagnoses**, Impaired Glucose Tolerance
11. **Stroke Transient Ischemic Attack (TIA):** Those with a diagnosed condition of **Stroke or TIA** in the patient population.
12. **Tobacco Use Disorder:** Those with a record of Tobacco Use.



Regions are organized to include populations of at least 20,000 residents to comply with HIPAA de-identification rules. Mouse over provides number of patients with condition.



Basic Demographics - Patient Name - patient's last name, first name, Sex, DOB

Encounters at Facility - count of the patient's visits within the client's facilities.

Encounters at Other Facilities - count of the patient's visits outside of the client's facilities.

Most Recent Encounter Date at Facility - the date of patient's last visit within the client's facilities.

Not Seen at Facility in 18 Months - a red indicator marks any patient that has not had a visit with the client in the last 18 months, blank otherwise.

Most Recent Provider at Facility - the latest provider name available on the patient's visits.

Most Recent Primary Payer at Facility - the latest primary name available on the patient's visits within the client facilities.

Included? - a checkbox indicating if the patient is marked as included in (dark green) or excluded from (white) the provider's view. Included (green) is the default state. A provider can change the Included/Excluded status of a patient by clicking on the checkbox on that patient's row. A popup window appears where a user can select an Exclude Reason, and select OK to save the Inclusion/Exclusion edit. Editing the Include? checkbox status updates the Last Pool Status Change field also.





Filters

The Patient Pool report can be filtered by the following quickviews:

- Status - filters the report to show only Included patients, only Excluded patients, or All patients (default) for the provider.



On subsequent logins, the provider user will not see the initial Welcome Page but will instead be taken directly to the data dashboards.
- Go to Dashboards - this link takes the user to the main menu for the data dashboards.

QUALITY METRICS



The **Quality Metrics dashboard** displays client results and analysis of preventive care procedures commonly required and approved for quality reporting programs for ambulatory practices. Individual measures are structured to meet NCQA, CMS and HEDIS requirements.

Measures include screening for colorectal, cervical and breast cancers, osteoporosis, pneumonia and influenza vaccines, controlled high blood pressure, diabetes and tobacco use.



Patient eligibility all patients in total client population that meet the QM guidelines. Individual measures may have exclusions based on age, gender or previous conditions. Details of the requirements for each condition and measure can be found in the Appendix.

'Performance' is a breakdown of how the patient can be categorized per the metric of interest.

Met - The patient has fallen into both the numerator and denominator requirements for the metric including any office visit criteria.

Not Met - The patient meets the denominator criteria, but does not meet the numerator criteria for the metric.

Unreported - The patient meets the numerator requirements for the metric, however the patient does **not** have the required office visit, excluding them from the denominator population to be considered "Met".

Period The 'Period' dropdown is a breakdown timeframes.

The three 'Period' options are:

Current -The current calendar year. **Previous** - The previous calendar year. **Historical** - Anything prior to the previous calendar year.

Measures help clients meet their MIPS Quality reporting requirements and other health insurance mandates by completing their records with dates and evidence of preventive screenings performed outside their facility. Export format allows ease of filtering and import into EMR or other tracking software.

Patient list for each measure display from each bar chart on the overview dashboard. Report columns vary dependent on the chart selection.



The need for follow up clinic appointments within 0-5 days or phone contact to check patient condition and answer questions, ensure medication compliance. Trend can vary by disease condition and facility. Drill down on bar chart opens patient specific list.



Displays the **FACILITIES** where patients returned for readmission. Organizations may know when patient readmitted to their facility, but not when they readmit elsewhere. Useful to identify trends in patient utilization, and targeted patient education and coordination between facilities. **Only admissions to another qualified Acute care facility IPPS count**. Transfers between hospitals, admits to Critical Access, Long term care, psychiatric or rehabilitation hospitals and other specialty facilities do not count.





Facility: The first facility where patient is admitted with one of the qualifying index conditions. In many cases, this will be restricted the client's eligible hospital, unless the client has multiple eligible facilities. **The hospital where the patient is first admitted** is the one that is assigned the potential penalty if the patient readmits at the same or any other eligible facility (**RETURN Facility**) within 30 days for any reason.

Specific **exclusion criteria for readmission** conditions included scheduled procedures, treatment for cancer and other diseases. KAMMCO structures data rules to comply with specific criteria to the extent possible based on available data. Lack of access to billing and claims and non-KHIN participant's data limits ability to completely replicate or comply with CMS or other payer algorithms. The intent of Readmissions is to provide early identification of potential risks.






Utilization includes all visits with a filtering option for recognized office visits codes versus non-office visits. There are several facility selection options. The left facility selection option is a 'pick list'.




