What does the DSA require me to do?

Participants are required to exchange HSSI with other participants via technical/electronic means and adhere to all DxF policies and procedures.

Where can I find my requirements?

The DSA establishes both programmatic and technical requirements through its policies, offering clear guidelines ("rules of the road") for participation.

However, each participant retains the flexibility to select the specific strategies and tools ("road & vehicle") they deem most effective in adhering to these regulations.
